

# How To Apply Horse Hoofies



1. It's important that your horse's feet be completely clean and dry.



2. Lightly sand the hoof wall with a sanding sponge to remove surface film.



3. Sand all the way around to the back of the heels.



4. All hoof walls should be clean and sanded.



5. Next, apply rubbing alcohol to soft, clean cloth and wipe over entire hoof wall area, including the very back heel areas, to remove all sanding dust. After the rubbing alcohol is applied, be careful not to touch the hoof wall with your hands as this may reintroduce oils that could hamper adhesion.



6. First place the *Hoofies* against the hoof wall to see where you might need to trim for best fit. After determining the fit, trim away any excess material.

7. Staying below the hairline, use the *Hoofies* logo to center it on the Hoof. Wrap the material around the foot towards the heels.

8. Apply pressure over entire surface ensuring proper adhesion to the hoof. After application, you may lift and trim material as needed and reapply with good pressure.

# How To Remove Horse Hoofies



1. Starting at heels lift the edge of the *Hoofies*.

2. Grab the edge and begin to pull.

3. Continue pulling towards the front.

4. Pull around the front to the opposite heel.

5. Pull *Hoofies* off completely.
